

Recycling Controller/Landfinder (Chester, North West)

We now require a suitably qualified and experienced professional to identify land and liase with farmers to provide a continuous recycling service to our customers in the North West and North Wales.

The Recycling Controller/Landfinder will be required to setup and maintain an efficient recycling service to our clients through effective landbank management. You will liase with farmers and report to the Operations Manager who will arrange for deliveries to be carried out. This work involves talking to Farmers and matching crop fertiliser requirements to sludge delivery schedules.

The Role:-

- Ensure suitable land is available for continuous recycling activities at minimal distance from various client sites.
- Maintain a forward recycling plan for a minimum of 6 weeks normal production from each site.
- Implement the sale of sludge as an alternative to chemical fertiliser.
- Prepare and submit recycling request paperwork for the client.
- Advise farmers on use of sludge as an organic fertiliser.
- Post farm information to Sludge Management Database.
- Prepare delivery paperwork and maps for drivers and operators.
- Carry out environmental risk assessments for individual sites.
- Identify, soil sample and assess new land to expand landbanks.
- Monitor completed sites and stockpiles and record outcomes.
- Audit deliveries to ensure environmental compliance
